date \_\_\_\_\_ at the rate of **six (6)** per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid **monthly** with interest from \_\_\_\_\_ and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten percent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **Mrs. Vance L. Wright**

all that tract or lot of land in **Grove** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of now the old Augusta Road about 12 miles south of the City of Greenville and adjoining lands of F. L. Rogers, Mrs. L. B. Waldrop, et al.

**BEGINNING** at stone on now the old Augusta Road and running thence with said road South ~~34.00~~ **5.22** chains to stone 30xm; thence by a new line S. 46-3/4 E. 3.36 to a stone in Georgia Road; thence S. 42 E. 12.60 to stone on old line; thence N. 31 1/2 E. 11.70 to stone 30xm; thence S. 84 1/2 W. 4.00 to stone; thence N. 7 1/2 W. 2.86 to stone in Georgia Road; thence along said road S. 89 1/2 W. 4.00 to stone in road thence further along said road S. 69 1/2 W. to stone 3x; thence N. 34 W. 5.75 to the beginning, containing 11 acres, more or less, save that part used for location of new Augusta Road.
