in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Shenandoah Life Insurance Co., Inc.

all that tract or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known as Lot No. 55 on a plat of property of Camilla Park, recorded in Plat Book G, page 225, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described according to a recent survey thereof by R. E. Dalton Engineer, February 1944, as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the North side of Beatrice Street at the point where said Street intersects a 20 foot alley, which point is 190.3 feet in a Southerly direction from the intersection of Beatrice Street and Flora Avenue; and running thence with Beatrice Street S. 21-28 E. 82 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 56; thence with line of that Lot S. 68-04 W. 197.9 feet to an iron pin on a 20 foot alley; thence with said alley N. 18-32 W. 39.5 feet to a stake at the intersection of said alley with another 20 foot alley running in an East to West direction; and running thence with the last mentioned 20 foot alley N. 55-53 E. 200.8 feet to the beginning corner.

The above is the same lot of land conveyed to me by the First National Bank of Greenville, S. C. as Trustee by deed dated August 8, 1934, recorded in Deed Book 172, page 97, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.
