
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the north side of Fast North Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 of a subdivision of the Sullivan property, and has the following metes, bounds, courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of Fast North Street, which point is 272 feet in an easterly direction from Manly Street (formerly Vulcan Street), at corner of Lot No. 4, formerly owned by R. K. Adams, and running thence N. 72 E. 68 feet along East North Street to corner of Lot No. 6; thence N. 13 W. 227 feet to stake on a 20 foot alley; thence with said alley S. 77 W. 68 feet to stake at corner of Lot No. 4; thence with line of said Lot, S. 13 E. 227 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 35/100 of an acre, more or less; being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by the heirs of Elizabeth A. Hewer, by several deeds recorded herewith."
