I, H. C. Brown SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, H. C. Brown

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to
FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of FOUR THOUSAND AND NO/100

(\$4,000.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of FORTY AND NO/100
(\$40.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, will be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, H. C. Brown

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me
the said H. C. Brown

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville and on the north side of Hampton Avenue in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 on a plat prepared by W. D. Neves, Engr., in February, 1912, and being more particularly described by a more recent survey and plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engr., on May 12, 1944, as follows, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Hampton Avenue at a point 118 feet in a westerly direction from the northwest corner of the intersection of Hampton Avenue and Lloyd Street, and running thence N. 48-30 E. 208 feet to an iron pin at a fence post; thence N. 41 W. 68 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-30 W. 41 feet to a stake; thence N. 41 W. 2 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 2; thence along the line of that lot, S. 48-30 W. 167.6 feet to the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 on the north side of Hampton Avenue; thence along the line of said Hampton Avenue, S. 41-30 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same lot conveyed to me by Roxie Alexander by deed dated July 13, 1945, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 278, page 10.
