## **MORTGAGE**

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I , Jesse M. Stroud

-----(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, on the Northern side of the Pickens to Marietta Road, containing two acres, more or less, and having, according to survey made by W.A.Hester, April 28, 1944, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at a stake in the Pickens Road, on the Southwestern line of the original 65\frac{1}{2}
acre tract, in line of property of E. L. Robinson, and running thence with line of said tract,
N. 61-30 W. 5 chains to a P. O. Stump(o,m.); thence N. 2-15 W. 4 chains to iron pin; thence S.
61-30 E. 6.50 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 2-15 E. 1.90 chains to iron pin in Pickens Road;
thence with said road, S. 43 W. 1.71 chains to the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by Claude Brazile by deed to be recorded herewith, and also being the same lot conveyed to Claude Brazile by deed recorded in Volume 263 at Page 206.
