SEND GREETINGS:

of anticipating the whole or any part thereof at any interest paying period.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to
become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should
be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection
of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either
of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mort-

of South Carolina, known as Lot No. two(2) of Pride & Patton Land Company, recorded in the
office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "E", at page 249, and, according
to said plat, described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Judson Road, corner of Lot No. one(1), and
running thence with line of said lot N. 36-15 E. two hundred and eleven (211) feet to an iron
pin, corner of Lots Nos. 44, 45 and 1; thence with line of Lot No. forty-three(43) N. 53-45 W.
sixty(60) feet to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 43, 42 and 3; thence with line of Lot No. three
(3) S. 36-15 W. two hundred and eleven (211) feet to an iron pin on Judson Road; thence with
Judson Road S. 53-45 E. sixty(60) feet to the beginning corner.
