MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, J. G. Davis
..... (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Forty-Two Hundred and No/100 DOLLARS (\$ 4200.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on the Southern side of White Horse Road near the City of Greenville, being shown as lots Nos. 2, 3 and 4 on plat of property of J. S. Machen made by G. A. Ellis on March 21, 1945, recorded in Plat Book "0" at Page 143 and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of White Horse Road 85 feet East from Staunton Bridge Road at corner of lot #5 and running thence with line of said lot, S. 40 W. 200 feet, more or less, to a stake in line of lot #6; thence with line of said lot, S. 42-00 E. 225 feet to a stake at corner of Lot #1; thence with line of said lot, N. 40 E. 200 feet, more or less, to a stake on White Horse Road; thence with the Southern side of said road, N. 41-00 W. 255 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by J.S.Machen by deed dated May 22, 1945, recorded in Volume 276 at Page 159."
