Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, State of South Carolina; on the Sandy Flat Road, and being known and designated as lot No. 3 as shown on Plat of the property of Batson, Boling and Trammell, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "O" at Page 193, and being more particularly described, according to a more recent survey prepared by Jim Hill in November 1947 as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Highway # 253, which pin is 161 feet from the intersection of Fairview Drive and which is the joint front corner of lots # 2 and 3, according to said plat and running thence with said Highway, N. 28-30 E. 78.31 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of lots # 3 and 4; thence with joint line of said lots, N. 40-30 W. 224.91 f et to an iron pin in line of 20-foot street; thence with said street, S. 26-12 E. 92.55 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots # 2 and 3; thence with joint line of said lots, S. 44 E. 218.66 feet to the beginning corner.
