

Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville township, State of South Carolina, known and designated as lots No. 46 and 47 on the west side of Flora Avenue as shown by Map No. 2 of the Camilla Park subdivision, The S. Marshall Estate, made by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, 1943 and recorded in BWC for Greenville County, in plat Book M, page 65 and being further described as follows:
