Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville State of South Carolina;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southern side of West Fairview Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 23 of Block G on revised plat of Highland Terrace and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book D, page 238 (and replatted in Plat Book K, page 121) and being shown by a more recent survey entitled "Property of W. W. Gaffney" prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service dated March 20, 1948, and having, according to said recent survey, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of West Fairview Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots No. 23 and 24 of Block G, which pin is located 200 feet West of the Southwestern intersection of West Fairview Avenue and Water Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 24, S. 9-52 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of an alley; thence with the Northern side of said alley, N. 80-08 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots No. 23 and 22; thence with the line of Lot No. 22, N. 9-52 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of West Fairview Avenue joint front corner of said last mentioned lots; thence with the Southern side of said avenue, S. 80-08 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
