"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE, Chick Springs Township, lying west of the town of Greer, on the north side of the National Highway (Old Highway No. 29) and on the west eide of Wood Street, and being shown and designated as lot No. 6 on Plat of Property known as R. L. Fors Lots prepared by J. H. Atkins, Surveyor, December 19th, 1922, and being the same lot conveyed to us by deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 289 at page 335, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-
