the day of the year
\$80.00 March 4, 1949, \$80.00 June 4, 1949, \$80.00 September 4, 1949; \$80.00 December 4, 1949 and a like amount on the 4th day of March, June, September and December thereafter until the entire principal sum is paid in full with the privilege of anticipating the whole or any part thereof on any installment date

with interest from date at the rate of three (3%) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid quarterly and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said South Carolina National Bank, as trustee for the John W. Arrington Foundation,

all that tract or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING on a black Gum, thence running S. 13 1/2 W. 9.54 to an iron pin on the Parker Road, thence with said road N. 3 1/2 W. 5.20 to the fork of Road, thence with another Road N. 42 E. 1.75 to a bend in Road, thence N. 20 E. 3.12 to an iron pin in said Road; thence S. 63 1/2 E. 40 links to the beginning corner and contains .87 acres, more or less.
