(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, just West of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron bin on White Circle, corner of lot No. 1, and running thence S. 20-27 W. 75% feet to a bin; thence S, 26-54 E. 50 feet to a bipe; thence N. 87-32 E. 210 feet to a bibe, corner of lot No. 3; thence with line of lot No. 3, N. 25-36 E. 424 feet to a bin on White Circle; thence with White Circle, N. 39-11 W. 100 feet to a bin; thence N. 15-31 W. 100 feet to a bin; thence N. 15-51 W. 100 feet to a bin; thence N. 19-51 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, and being lot No. 2 as shown on Plat made by C. H. Millard, Eng., December 1923, and being known also as lot No. 35 and a portion of lots Nos. 32, 33 and 34 and 36 of Fallis Annex, containing 3.41 acres, more or less, being the same property conveyed to John B. Barker by Sara Inez Weathers by deed dated February 7, 1941, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. S.C. February 10, 1941, in Book of Deeds 230 at Page 202."

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
