"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Capers Street, in the City of Greenville, being the major portion of Lot No. 75, as shown on plat of Crescent Terrace, recorded in Plat Book E at Page 137, and also being shown as Lot No. 3 on plat of the property of Thomas J. Ligon, Sr., made by J. Mac Richardson in June 1948, and having according to the last mentioned plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 75 and 74, as shown on plat of Crescent Terrace property, said point being the southwest corner of the property of Thomas J.
