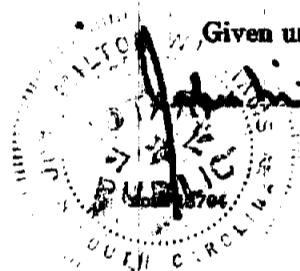
Renunciation of Dower.
