to be paid as follows: Forty & no/100 Dollars (\$40.00)

to be paid between the first and fifth day of each and every month succeeding the date hereof until the interest and principal is paid in full.

with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Morrow Street, corner of lot now or formerly owned by R. W. Bridwell, and runs thence S. 78-00 E. 115 feet to a point on line in the rear of H. E. Bridwell barn; thence N. 11-50 E. 65 feet; thence N. 78-00 W. 115 feet to a point on East side of Morrow Street; thence with the said Morrow Street South 65 feet to the beginning corner.
