McGee Horton, running thence N. 39 W. 2.25 to iron pin by Huff, thence S. 56-3/4 W. 35 to point in the center of the highway, thence S. 55 E. 2.25 along center of highway, thence N. 60-1/2 E. 52 to beginning corner, bounded on the north by Page, on the East by J. Mc. Horton, on the south by Chandler School lot, and on the west by highway. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. W.
