C. or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Thirty-Two and 92/100- - - - - - - - - - - - - - - - Dollars (\$ 32.92 , 1949 , and on the first day of each month therecommencing on the first day of September after until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of August

Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina: in Greenville Township, on the Eastern side of Carolina Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 10, Block J, on Plat of Section 5 of East Highland Estates made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February 1941, recorded in Plat Book K, at Page 78 and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Carolina Avenue, 520 feet South from Laurel Creek Lane at corner of lot No. 9 and running thence with the line of of said lot, S. 76-39 E. 194.7 feet to a stake on a 5 foot utility strip; thence with said utility strip, S. 00-24 E. 110 feet to a stake, at corner of lot No. 11; thence with the line of said lot, N. 63-50 W. 238.8 feet to a stake on Carolina Avenue; thence with the curve of the Eastern side of Carolina Avenue, the chord of which is N. 25-14 E. 55 feet, to the beginning corner.
