porated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Six Thousand and No/100- - - - -
Dollars (\$ 6000.00), with interest from date at the rate of
- - - -Four- - - - -per centum (4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable
at the office of Canal Insurance Company
in Greenville, S.C., or at such other place as the holder of the note may
designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Thirty-Six and 36/100
Dollars (\$ 36.36), commencing on the first day of
December, 1949, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and
interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and

whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does
grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described

State of South Carolina; in Greenville Township, on the Southwest side of Dupont Drive,
in the City of Greenville, being the major portion of lot No. 101 on Plat of Isaqueena
Park, made by Pickell and Pickell on June 3, 1947, recorded in Plat Book P, at Page
131, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southwest side of Dupont Drive 370.5 feet Northwest
from Oxford Street, at corner of property of Mary Milwee Welborn, and running thence
with line of said lot, S. 39-33 W. 168.15 feet to a stake in line of lot No. 79;
thence with line of said lot, N. 43-21 W. 50 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 102;
thence with line of said lot, N. 29-38 E. 155.7 feet to a stake on Dupont Drive;
