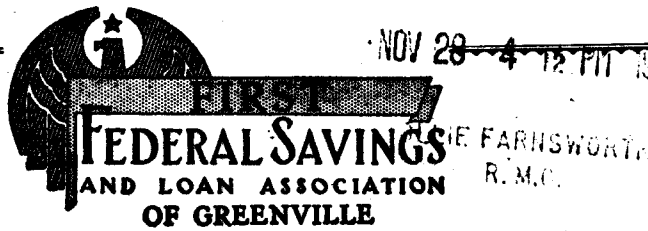

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, J. H. Kellett, of Greenville County, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said J. H. Kellett

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full

and just sum of TEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$10,000.00.)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$100.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. H. Kellett

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me, the said

J. H. Kellett, in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, on the Augusta Road, being the same lot conveyed to J. McGee Horton by L. J. Huff by deed dated July 26, 1938, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 205 at page 35, with a full description therein from survey of W. M. Nash, Surveyor, herein incorporated by reference. Being the same conveyed to me by J. McGee Horton by deed dated June 29, 1943, recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 254, page 372.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing one-tenth of one acre, more or less, and being more fully described by metes and bounds from a survey of W. M. Nash, Surveyor, July 22, 1938 as follows: BEGINNING at the corner of Chandler School House lot and Page and J. McGee Horton, running thence N. 39 W. 2.25 to iron pin by Huff; thence S. 56 3/4 W. 35 to point in the center of the highway; thence S. 35 E. 2.25 along center of highway; thence N. 60 1/2 E. .52 to beginning corner, bounded on the north by Page, on the East by J. Mc. Horton, on the South by Chandler School lot, and on the West by highway. Being the same conveyed to me by J. W. Page by deed dated July 26, 1938, recorded in the R.M.C. office in Vol. 205, page 32.
