MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, **W. H. Burton**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **Citizens Lumber Company**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of **One Thousand and No/100 - - -**

DOLLARS (\$ 1000.00 ),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: **in monthly installments of \$25.00 each on the 1st day of each month hereafter, beginning March 1, 1950, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal until paid in full, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed semi-annually and paid monthly.**

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on **New Dunham Bridge Road, being shown as lot No. 15, Block 3, Page 243, of County Block Book, and being more particularly described as follows:**

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of New Dunham Bridge Road, at corner of property owned by J. A. Cresswell, and running thence with New Dunham Bridge Road, S. 15 W. 210 feet to iron pin; thence S. 65 E. 315.5 feet to iron pin; thence N. 15 E. 210 feet to pin in line of property of J. A. Cresswell; thence with his line, N. 65 W. 315.5 feet to the beginning corner, containing  $1\frac{1}{2}$  acres, and being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Volume 394 at Page 8."
