FOR VALUE RECEIVED, I promise to pay to the order of CAROLINA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY the principal sum of THREE HUNDRED NIMETY-TWO THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED (\$392,500.00) DOLLARS, with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of four and one-half (4%) per cent per annum, said interest and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows:

Beginning on the day of fallenting, 1950, and on lith day of each month thereafter, the sum of TWO THOUSAND ETCHT HUNDRED (\$2,800.00) DOLLARS, to be applied on the interest and principal of this note, said payments to continue up to and including day of December , 1956; and beginning on the 11th day of January , 1957, and on the 11th day of each month thereafter, the sum of FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500.00) DOLLARS, day of each month to be applied on the interest and principal of this note, said payments of FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500.00) DOLLARS per month to continue up to and including the llth day of 1965, when any balance remaining due on principal, with accrued interest, shall be payable in full. Each of the aforesaid monthly payments is to be applied first to interest at the rate of four and onehalf (445) per cent per annum on the principal sum of THREE HUNDRED NINETY-TWO THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED (\$392,500.00) DOLLARS, or so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid, and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.
