NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, and having, according to Plat made by McPherson Company on November 21st, 1949, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a pin at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Evelyn Avenue and a road leading to Laurens Road, and running thence with the Southern side of said unnamed Road, N. 75-17 E. 18.2 feet to pin; thence S. 23-08 E. 318.45 feet to pin in line of Lot No. 12, as shown on original Plat of C. F. Putman property; thence N. 85-07 W. 151.45 feet to pin on the Eastern side of Evelyn Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of Evelyn Avenue, N. 1-37 E. 301.45 feet to the point of beginning."
