MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, James B. Staton (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto South Carolina National Bank as Trustee for the John W. Arrington Foundation (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Two Thousand and No/100- - - -

DOLLARS (\$2000.00 ),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Three per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$125.00 three months after date and a like payment of \$125.00 quarterly thereafter until paid in full, together with interest at the rate of three per cent per annum to be computed and paid quarterly

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Western side of Parkwood Drive near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 135 on a plat of North Hills made by R.E. Dalton in April, 1925, recorded in Plat Book H at Page 130 and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Western side of Parkwood Drive, 528.1 feet South of East Hillcrest Drive at corner of lot No. 134, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 71-00 W. 140 feet to a stake; thence with the line of lot No. 118, S. 19-17 W. 70 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 136; thence with the line of said lot, S. 71-00 E. 140 feet to a stake on Parkwood Drive; thence with the Western side of Parkwood Drive, N. 19-17 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by Frances Farnsworth Galloway by deed recorded in Volume 296 at Page 105.
