MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:
I. Gladys Davis Johnston, of Greenville County
WHEREAS, I the saidGlady.s. Davis Johnston
in and bymycertain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presentsamwell and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full
and just sum of Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 (\$.13,500.00)
Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of
One Hundred, Fourteen and No/100 (\$ 114.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.
NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That, the said Gladys Davis Johnston
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms
of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars tome, the said
in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon,
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville. Township, partly within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the northeast side of Augusta street, and being designated as Lot No. 6 on a plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E", at page 136, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Augusta Street 553.3 feet from East Prentiss Avenue, and running thence along the joint line of Lots 5 and 6, N. 42-07 E. 180.2 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of an alley; thence along said alley, S. 71-45 E. 35 feet to pin; thence continuing with said alley, S. 73-24 E. 31.1 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of Lot No. 7, S. 42-07 W. 207.6 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Augusta Street; thence with the north east side of Augusta Street, N. 47-53 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be instanted thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Fay W. Williams by deed dated November 13, 1944 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 269, at page 175."
