with interest from date at the rate of five & one-half/ per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi-annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

Kellett and Osby Woods in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. E. Robinson, as Trustee under the B. M. McGee Will, his successors and assigns, forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on Little Horse Creek, branch waters of Reedy River, about twenty-one miles from the City of Greenville and about ten miles from Pelzer, on a road which leads from Fork Shoals to the Augusta Road, and also on a road which leads from the Fork Shoals Road to Princeton, having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat made by W. M. Nash, and dated October 30, 1912, towit:
