aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The South Carolina National Bank, Trustee, under agreement with Nelson B. Arrington, dated March 23, 1945, their successors and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Easterly side of Summit Drive, within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and being a por tion of tracts Nos. 1 and 2, according to plat of property of J. D. Bridges, according to plat thereof, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book E, at page 170 and having, according to more recent survey by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated March 1951, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
