Dill, Surveyor, dated June 24, 1946, bounded by lands of Raymond Oneal, Ella McGowan, C.H. Duck and others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Raymond Oneal by deed of Ella McGowan, et al., recorded in Deed Book 295, page 6, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
