All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the North side of Oak Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 7 of the property of E. E. Watson as shown on plat thereof made by C. M. Furman, Jr. and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 11, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Oak Street at the rear corner of Lot No. 3, which point is 120 feet East of the intersection of Paris Mountain Road, and running thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 3, 2 and 1, N 18 W 120 feet to an iron pin; thence N 72 E 45 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 8; thence along the line of that lot, S 18 E 120 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the North side of Oak Street; thence along the North side of Oak Street; thence along the North side of Oak Street, S 72 W 45 feet to the beginning corner.
