# MORTGAGE

organised and existing under the laws of South Carolina, a corporation hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Seventy-Three Hundred Fifty and 1/100

Dollars (\$7350.00), with interest from date at the rate of Four- - - - per centum ( 4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of

Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association in Greenville, S.C., or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Forty-Four and 54/100

Dollars (\$44.54), commencing on the first day of June, 1952, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of May, 1972.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville State of South Carolina; on the East side of LeGrand Boulevard, in the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 12, of Section A, on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Walton & Neves August 1951, recorded in Plat Book BB at Pages 30 and 31, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of LeGrand Boulevard 62 feet South from Don Drive, at corner of lot 13, and running thence with line of said lot, N. 88-30 E. 156.6 feet to a stake; thence S. 1-30 E. 74 feet to a stake at corner of lot 11; thence with the line of said lot, S. 88-30 W. 150 feet to a stake on LeGrand Boulevard; thence with the Eastern side of said Boulevard, N. 6-35 W. 74.3 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by L. A. Moseley and John T. Douglas by deed to be recorded herewith.

Together with all and singular the improvements thereon and the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining; all the rents, issues, and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues, and profits until default hereunder); all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described and in addition thereto the following described household appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned;
