C., in Plat Book "Y", at page 55, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwest corner of the intersection of High Valley Boulevard and Creek Shore Drive, and running thence along the south side of Creek Shore Drive, N. 66-48 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 76, S. 17-32 W. 324.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 80-14 E. 172.6 feet to an iron pin on the west side of High Valley Boulevard; thence with the west side of High Valley Boulevard, N. 29-30 E. 91 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with High Valley Boulevard, N. 5-45 W. 222.9 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
