all that tract or lot of land in
Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina
situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South
Carolina, containing 88.18 acres, more or less, situate approximately
15 miles south of Greenville on a public road, being South Carolina
Highway No. 8 between Pelzer and Wares, and being shown on plat of
