"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of the intersection of North Main Street Extension and Fairview Avenue, and running thence along the south side of Fairview Avenue, S. 66-30 E. 190 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14-47 W. 85 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 3; thence along the line of said Lot No. 3, N. 66-30 W. 190 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the east side of North Main Street Extension; thence along the east side of North Main Street Extension, N. 14-47 E. 85 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Ella B. Ward by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
