with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$20.00 on May 15th, 1953 and a like payment of \$20.00 on the 15th day of each with interest thereon from date at the rate of month thereafter until paid in full, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per cent, per annum, to be computed semi-annually and paid monthly

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as tract No. 2 of property of L. F. Nolin as shown on plat of W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated September 1946, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on Parker Road, joint corner of lots 1 and 2 and running thence S. 60-15 W. 159.4 feet to an iron pin in line of lot 3; thence along line of lot 3, S. 24-50 E. 93.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 60-15 E. 203.3 feet to an iron pin on Parker Road; thence N. 50-20 W. 100 feet along Parker Road to the beginning corner.
