the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and
designated as Lot No. 202, and the westerly and adjoining one-half (1/2) of
Lot No. 203, according to plat of Cleveland Forest prepared by Dalton &
Neves in May, 1940, as revised through October, 1950, as recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book M,
at Pages 56 and 57, and having according to said plat the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwesterly side of Trail's End at
joint front corner of Lots Nos. 201 and 202; thence along the joint line
of said lots, N. 58-50 W. 177.2 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner
of Lots Nos. 201 and 202 on the Southeasterly side of a 20 foot alley;
thence along said alley on an angle, the chord of which is N. 36-01 E.,
94 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 202 and 203;
thence further along said alley, on an angle, the chord of which is
N. 49-54 E., 44 feet to an iron pin at the center point in the rear line
of Lot No. 203; thence in a straight line through the center of Lot No. 203,
S. 38-54 E., 185.1 feet to an iron pin at the center point in the front
line of Lot No. 203 on the Northwesterly side of Trail's End; thence along
Trail's End on an angle, the chord of which is S. 56-10 W. 25 feet to an
