in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Charles E. Robinson, his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a portion of Lot No. 11 according to a plat of the subdivision of land made by J. Jake Smith, dated August 1928 and recorded in the S. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 475, page 377, and being the following notes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest corner of the intersection of Locust Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, and running thence 31 feet southwest of the intersection of Locust Street and Virginia Street and running thence along the line of Lot No. 12, 31 feet to a point on the line of Lot No. 11; thence along Lot No. 11 along the property of C. E. Looper N. 31-00 E. 30 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Locust Avenue; thence along the southwestern side of Locust Avenue N. 31-00 E. 30 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Locust and Michelle Streets; thence along the southeastern side of Michelle Street S. 14-32 E. 30 feet to the point of beginning.
