All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Russell Avenue (formerly Laurel Street) and Cary Street (formerly East Croft Street) in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 7 on plat of property of D. R. Cain, Trustee, made by W. M. Rast, Engineer, October 1928, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H", at page 135, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
