TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, Harry Lee Tate and Polly J. Tate,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$ 10,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greer, in Chick Springs Township, located on the East side of Miller Street, bounded on the North by Mary Gibson Jackson, on the East by Commission of Public Works of Greer, on the South by Mrs. J. L. Gibson, Sr., and on the West by Miller Street, being shown as lot No. 1 on a plat of property made for I. H. Gibson Estate by W. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated August 24, 1930, having the following courses and distances: Beginning on an iron pin on the East side of Miller Street, Mrs. J. L. Gibson lot corner, and runs thence with said street N. 17.01 E. 71.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with Mrs. Jackson's line S. 72.37 E. 231.7 feet to an iron pin on line of Commission of Public Works; thence with said line N. 71.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 72.37 E. 231.3 feet to the beginning, and that all of said lot of land conveyed to us, the undersigned, by W. S. Brockman, Sr., and Roy C. Taylor, Jr., by deed recorded in Book 10, Page 294, to the recorder herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
