WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Five Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 - - - - - -

(\$ 5,500.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate specified in said note, to be repaid in installments of

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Northern side of Talley Bridge Road in the Slater Manufacturing Company Village, at Slater, being known and designated as Lot 9, Block "K", as shown on a blot entitled "Plat Showing Property owned by Slater Manufacturing Co., located at Slater, Greenville County, S. C." made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., December 26, 1951, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book CC, at page 147, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Talley Bridge Road at the joint front corner of Lots 8 and 9, and running thence along the common line of said two lots, N. 18-09 W. 228.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71-51 W. 140 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 9 and 10; thence along the common line of said two lots, S. 18-09 E. 228.5 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Talley Bridge Road; thence along the Northern side of Talley Bridge Road, N. 71-51 E. 140 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same property conveyed to us by J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. by deed dated September 20, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 508, at page 513."
