M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P", at pages 74 and 75, said lot fronting 75 feet along the Northwest side of Princeton Avenue, and running back to a depth of 150 feet on the Northeast side, to a depth of 150 feet on the Southwest side, and being 75 feet across the rear.
