Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. on the north side of Buncombe Street, the west side of Laurens Street and the south side of West North Street in the City of Greenville and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 9 and 15, according to a plat of the property of Rush Brothers dated January, 1924 by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F", page 184 and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
