All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the north side of East North Street and on the south side of Davis Avenue, and having, according to a plat of Lawyers Office Building, Inc., Greenville, S. C., prepared by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., July, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
