Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina: in the Town of Fountain Inn, S. C. being known as the greater portion of lot no. 8 of the W. Shell Thackston property made by W. J. Riddle dated March, 1946 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book B at Page 131, and having according to a more recent survey entitled Property of Charles A. Taylor made by T. C. Adams dated December 29, 1954 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Thackston Street at the joint front corner of lots nos. 7 and 8, which iron pin is situate 70 feet northwest of the intersection of Thackston Street and Green Street, and which iron pin is also situate 639 feet southeast of the intersection of Thackston Street and Jones Mill Road and running thence along the line of lot no. 7, N 47-40 E, 202 feet, joint rear corners of lots nos. 7 and 8; thence S 42-20 E, 60 feet to an iron pin; thence along the northwestern side of Green Street, S 44-48 W, 201.5 feet to an iron pin to the intersection of Green Street and Thackston Street and running thence along the northeastern side of Thackston Street, N 42-20 W, 70 feet to the point of beginning.
