All of that parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township or Greenville County, South Carolina, located about two miles North from the City of Greer and on the East side of Fairview Drive (sometimes called Clearview Drive), known and designated as Lot No. 4 on a plat of property made for W. Dennis Smith by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated July 29, 1952, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "T", at page 452, and having according to said plat and according to a more recent plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S. C., dated December 29, 1954, entitled "Property of Jack E. Hiatt and Cartland B. Hiatt" the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern margin of Fairview Drive, joint corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 4 on said plat, and runs thence with the Johnson line of these two lots N. 83-40 E. 199.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 22-53 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 6 on said plat; thence with the common line of these two lots S. 82-53 W. 209.7 Feet to an iron pin on the Eastern margin of Fairview Drive; thence with the margin of said street N. 19-45 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner.
