Charles H. Butler and Mabel W. Butler of  
Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Six Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$6,750.00), with interest from date at the rate of four and one-half per centum (4-1/2%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Thirty Seven and 50/100 Dollars (\$37.50), commencing on the first day of February, 1955, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of January, 1960.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina: near the City of Greenville, being known as portions of lots nos. 21 and 22 according to Block E on Plat of Washington Heights made by W. O. McDowell, Jr. and Julian L. Moore dated December, 1944 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at Page 107; and having according to the plat of T. C. Adams dated January 4, 1955 entitled Property of Charles H. Butler and Mabel W. Butler, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book II at Page 18 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the western side of Washington Loop, which iron pin is situate 27.9 feet north of the joint front corner of lots nos. 21 and 20, and which iron pin is also situate 315.9 feet north of the intersection of Washington Loop and Pine Street and running thence through the line of lot no. 21, S 78-10 E, 32 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 19 and 20; thence with the line of lot no. 10, N 78-45 E, 59.8 feet to an iron pin; thence through the line of lot no. 22, N 22-15 E, 100 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Washington Loop; thence with the northern side of Washington Loop, following the curve thereof, the chord of which is, S 62-35 E, 48 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said curve the chord of which is S 18-0 E, 71 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
