AND WHEREAS, in pursuance of the foregoing, and of all and every legal power and authority in it vested, the Mission proposes to make and execute, and from time to time hereafter to issue and deliver notes so secured:

GRANTING CIA USE AND PROVISOS

NOW, THEREFORE, this mortgage witnesseth: That the Mission, for the purpose of securing the payment of the bearer notes and the interest thereon, according to the terms thereof, and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar to it paid by the trustee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the trustee, and to its successors and assigns, the following described property, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the west side of West Washington Street and having according to plat of the property of Elizabeth M. Gosnell by W. J. Riddle, surveyor, September 1948, and to be recorded, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at southwest intersection of West Washington Street and Forest Alley and running thence with West Washington Street N. 48-50 W. 60.1 feet to the outside corner of brick wall, thence with northern face of said wall S. 41-02 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 48-50 E. 60 feet to an iron pin on Forest Alley, thence with Forest Alley N. 41-05 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning and being the same property conveyed to Paul F. Beacham, W. T. Thomas, and G. V. Yonce, as trustees of Greenville Rescue Mission, by Catherine Fewell McNamara, J. D. Poag, and J. E. Gosnell, by deed dated October 1, 1951, and recorded in the R. M.
