To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

WE, CURTIS M. HEAD AND BOBBIE M. HEAD, SEND GREETING:

Whereas, we, the said Curtis M. Head and Bobbie M. Head,  
in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
presents, are well and truly indebted to Thornwell Orphanage, Clinton, South  
Carolina,  
in the full and just sum of Fifty-seven Hundred and No/100ths (\$5,700.00) Dollars,  
, to be paid ninety (90) days from date,

, with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of five per centum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in  
the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder  
thereof necessary for the protection of his or its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note  
or this mortgage, in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the  
mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees,  
this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said Curtis M. Head and Bobbie M. Head  
, in consideration of the said debt and  
sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Thornwell  
Orphanage, Clinton, South Carolina, according to the terms of the said note, and also in  
consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to US, the said Curtis M. Head and

Bobbie M. Head, in hand well and truly paid by the said Thornwell Orphanage,  
Clinton, South Carolina,  
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bar-  
gained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THORNWELL  
ORPHANAGE, CLINTON, SOUTH CAROLINA:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 11  
of Paris Mountain Heights as shown on plat by J. C. Hill, Surveyor dated  
September 13, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County  
in Plat Book HH, page 151, and having, according to said plat, the following  
metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of a thirty foot road at the joint front  
corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, and running thence with the line of Lot No.  
12 N. 1-00 W. 206.8 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly  
belonging to Jervey; thence with Jervey's line N. 63-10 E. 80 feet to an iron  
pin in the corner of property now or formerly belonging to Ashmore; thence with  
Ashmore's line S. 6-05 E. 278.9 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 10;  
thence with the line of Lot No. 10 S. 82-00 W. 19.5 feet to an iron pin in the  
center of said thirty-foot road; thence with the center of said road the follow-  
ing curvature thereof (the chords of which are N. 34-20 W. 50 feet and  
N. 85-00 W. 50 feet) to the beginning corner.
