WHEREAS, I, the said Mrs. Callie Self Coker,

am indebted in and by my certain Note bearing date the 22nd day of July, A. D., 1955, in the sum of Eighty Thousand (\$80,000.00) - - - - - DOLLARS, payable to BANK OF GREENWOOD, or Order, on January 22nd, 1956, together with interest thereon from date at the rate of 5% per annum, and if not so paid when due, the interest shall become an interest bearing demand at the same rate as the principal, and providing that if said note or obligation is placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, it is agreed that 10% of the principal and interest as computed to be due shall be allowed as and for an attorney's fee; together with certain other provisions

TRACT NO. 1: All that certain tract or parcel of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Blocker-Limestone District, in the County of Edgefield, State of South Carolina, containing one thousand fifty-five (1055) acres, more or less, and being bounded on the North by Rocky Creek, by lands formerly of Mary Irvin, now of the Estate of Dr. J. H. Self, and by other lands of the Estate of Dr. J. H. Self, and by lands formerly of Mrs. C. Strother, now of H. H. Smith; on the East by lands formerly of L. H. Hamilton, now of Mrs. W. C. Williams; on the South by lands of the Estate of Dr. J. H. Self, by lands formerly of Mrs. Martha E. Strom, now of the Estate of Dr. J. H. Self, and by lands formerly of C. H. B.
