(\$ 5,600.00 ) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Paris Mountain Township, on the northwest side of Furman Hall Road, and being known and designated as all of Lots Nos. 3 and 4 and a part of Lot No. 2 of a subdivision known as Furman Terrace, as shown on plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, March, 1937, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book I, at page 59, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Furman Hall Road in the front line of Lot No. 2, which point is 175 feet from the northwest intersection of Furman Hall Road and Cherrydale Drive, and running thence on a line through Lot No. 2, N. 60-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of said Lot No. 2; thence N. 29-30 E. 130 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 5; thence along the line of Lot No. 5, S. 60-30 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the northwest side of Furman Hall Road; thence along the northwest side of Furman Hall Road; thence along the northwest side of Furman Hall Road, S. 29-30 W. 130 feet to the beginning corner."

The above described property is the same conveyed to S. Harry Drummond and Eleanor Drummond by Fannie E. Stover, et al. by deed dated December 6, 1939 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 216, page 208, and also by deed of Janie W. Goldsmith to S. Harry Drummond and Eleanor Drummond by deed dated July 3, 1940 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 223, at page 345, the said Eleanor Drummond having since conveyed her undivided one-half interest in said lots to S. Harry Drummond by deed dated February 23, 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 404, at page 35.

The last payment on this mortgage, if not sooner paid, will become due and payable 15 years after date.
