All that certain parcel or tract of land containing one hundred and eighty (180) acres, more or less, known as Tracts Nos. 5, 7, 8 and 9 of the J. D. Lanford property, lying and being on both sides of the Rutherford Road, now State Highway No. 14, and on both sides of the Goodjoin Road, about 12 miles northward from the City of Greer, in Gowensville School District, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, bounded by lands, now or formerly, owned by Wade Staggs, Andrew Neves, Paul S. Poole and the A. B. Groce Estate. Said tract of land is particularly shown and delineated on a plat of the J. D. Lanford property by W. P.
